

Survey Results

1. Of the 285 owners, 220 owners confirmed receiving the survey. (77% of the ownership)
2. Of the 220 who received the survey 202 participated. (70% of the ownership)
3. Of the 202 owners who participated 85 owners (42%) wanted the new location for the pool, 67 owners (33%) wanted the old location and 49 owners (24%) did not have a preference. 1 owner (0%) did not want to answer design question.

Sited reasons from ownership for new location:

- a. More aesthetically pleasing design
- b. Good idea to have all the recreational activities next to each other
- c. Ability to sunbathe early morning without the building obstructing morning sun
- d. Have it closer to water (better view)

Sited reasons from ownership for old location:

- a. Existing pool is still good (owners were told a new pool will be constructed regardless of location)
- b. Cheaper to build a pool in current location (owners were told cost was comparable)
- c. Current location allows for a more quite and relaxing environment
- d. Building will offer early morning shade
- E. Owners who currently have pool view will lose view

4. Of the 202 owners who participated in survey, 42 did not want to comment on possible monetary budgets for the project. The average for the suggested amount illustrated below was acquired from 160 owners who answered budgetary question. A suggested range from 5,000 minimum - 10,000 Maximum was given for owners to choose from. Owners were able to pick any desired dollar amount in the stated range they felt comfortable spending for the construction of the pool, clubhouse and Marina building. (Owners were told financing would be available)
 - a. The average amount that owners would feel comfortable spending on the project is \$6,393.00. Leaving the association a budget of \$1,822,005.00 dollars to complete the project.
